-\$1,200 to attend Madison Area Technical College (Madison College)-

Description

A **\$1,200** scholarship will be offered for the upcoming 2016-2017 academic year to a **Madison High School** senior who creates the winning artwork expressing the peace topic **“Why War is NOT the Answer.”**

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to any senior at a Madison public high school who will graduate in 2016. Applicants must plan to enroll at Madison Area Technical College (Madison College)--full-time or part-time--beginning the fall semester 2016 to be eligible to receive this award.

Deadline

- Applications must be received no later than April 2, 2016. Late applications are not considered.

Application Requirements

A properly completed application package includes (1) an application cover sheet, (2) photograph of original artwork, (3) an artist's statement, (4) a letter of reference, (5) a copy of academic transcript

- SEND VIA EMAIL to gardendoula@yahoo.com with ART SCHOLARSHIP in the subject line.
 - ART WORK: Digital photo(s) of original visual artwork (any media) that expresses the artist's response to **“War is NOT the Answer”**. One submission per student.
 - ARTIST'S STATEMENT including Artist's name / age-grade / school / teacher's name/ media used AND a short description of how the submitted artwork intends to express the theme **“War is NOT the Answer”**.
 - COVER SHEET: Download and complete the application cover sheet, which may be obtained from the scholarship committee of Madison Veterans for Peace by going to the web site at www.madisonvfp.org. Contact Paul McMahan (608-233-1997) if you would like to have a paper application mailed to you. Applications are also available in your school guidance office. If using a paper application, scan it and email it along with hard copies of photo and artist's statement .
