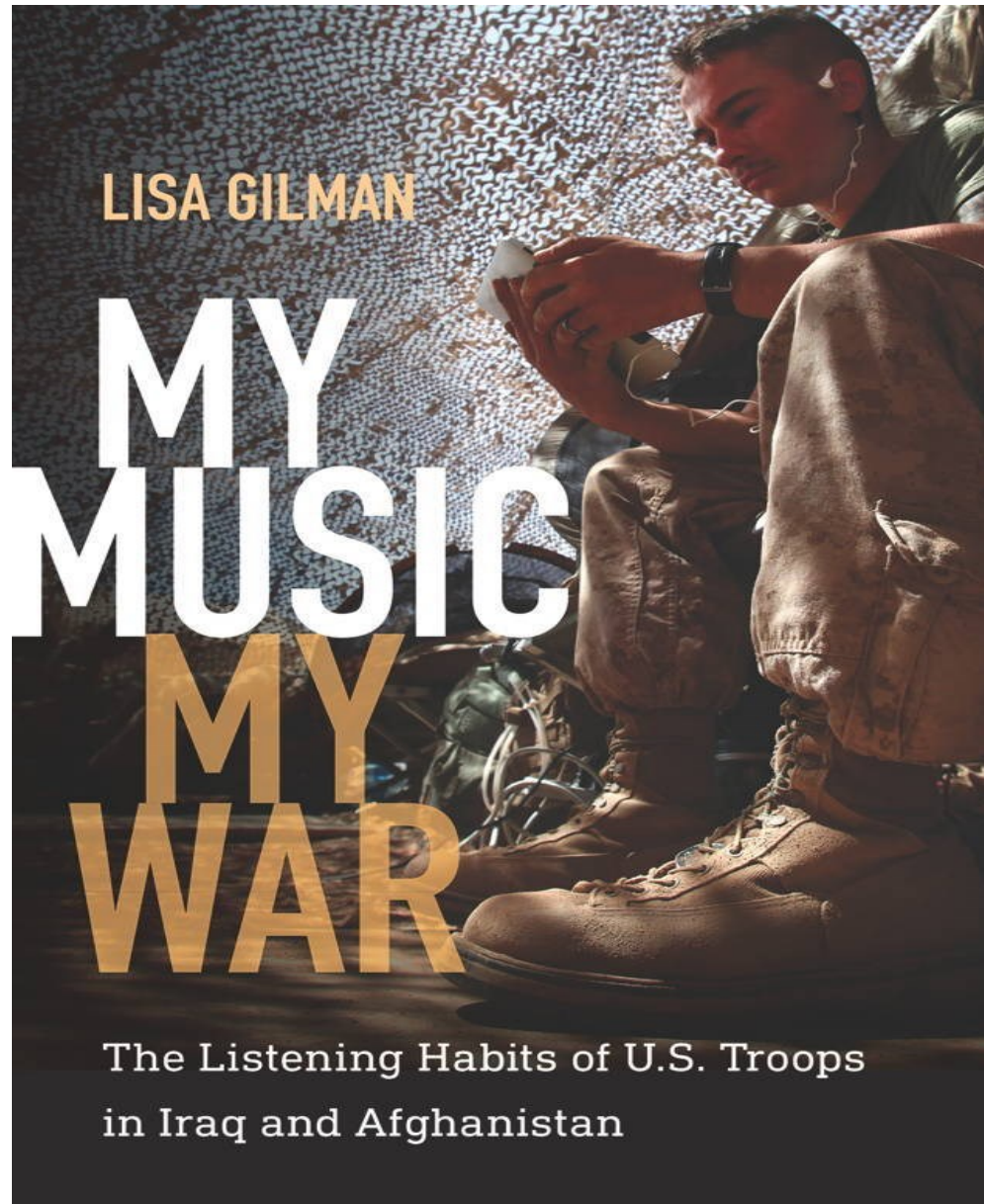


# Meet Author **LISA GILMAN**
