Veterans for Peace \$1,000 Dr. James Allen Memorial Scholarship To Attend Madison Area Technical College (Madison College)

Description

A \$1,000 scholarship is offered for the 2019-2020 academic year to a Madison High School senior student who writes the best original essay on the peace topic announced below.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to <u>any senior student at a Madison public high school</u> who will graduate in 2019. Applicants must plan to enroll at Madison Area Technical College (Madison College)--full-time or part-time--beginning the fall semester 2019, to be eligible to receive this award.

Deadline

Applications must be postmarked not later than Friday May 3, 2019.

Application Requirements

A properly completed application package includes (1) an application <u>cover sheet</u>, (2) a *typed* 2-3 page original essay, and (3) a grade transcript. In addition, two (2) letters of reference should be sent <u>independently</u> to the scholarship committee. Applications without letters of reference will not be considered. See *note below.

- Complete the *application cover sheet*. Photocopied forms are acceptable. Applications may be obtained from the scholarship committee of Madison Veterans for Peace by going to the web site at www.madisonvfp.org and downloading the document. Contact Paul McMahon (608-215-5031) if you would like to have an application mailed or emailed to you or if you require assistance. Application materials are also available in your school guidance office.
- Write a 2-3 page typed (double spaced) essay on the topic:

"Why I Believe Violence is Never a Solution"

The essay may address the topic of violence from a national or international perspective (such as war) or from a local neighborhood or community point of view. For example, what does the violence of war accomplish? Nationally or locally: what does community violence accomplish? What is role of protest? Be thoughtful and convincing.

Applicants are encouraged to visit www.madisonvfp.org to be familiar with our Statement of Purpose.

Submission

- Applications must be <u>postmarked</u> *no later than Friday, May 3. Grade transcrips should be mailed directly to the same address above.
- Late applications cannot be considered. If you have a question, check with a guidance counselor or contact Paul McMahon (608-215-5031).

*Note: Letters of reference and a grade trascript should be sent by the author directly to the scholarship committee, not sent with the student application and essay submitted by the student applicant. Applicants should provide the Committee's mailing address (or email address) to whomever will be submitting the letter of reference as well as the office issuing grade transcripts.

Award Notification

The Committee will notify the winning applicant on or about May15. The award check will be paid to the winning student upon enrollment confirmation at MATC for the fall semester 2019.

Late applications are not considered.

Letters of reference must be independently submitted by the author to the post box address or email address. Make sure your reference letter writer has the scholarship committee's address. Lack of reference letters will disqualify the application.

VFP will notify the winner only, and no later than May 15, 2019.

Application materials become the property of the VFP Scholarship Committee. Student information may be used to verify enrollment status at MATC. All information submitted is retained by the Scholarship Committee is treated as <u>confidential</u>. Veterans for Peace reserves the right not to make an award if applications are incomplete or deemed inadequate in quality.
