



Contact your City Alder and ask them to endorse the City of Madison Back from the Brink Resolution

***Please act quickly as we don't have much time! Alder elections will be held on April 4th.
Below are resources that will help you reach out to your Alder.***

The City of Madison Back from the Brink Resolution is part of a national campaign that calls on the US government to take five steps to prevent nuclear war. The Resolution also commits the City of Madison to nuclear weapon - free investments and contracts.

Contact your City Alder as soon as possible and ask them to endorse the City of Madison Back from the Brink Resolution. Urge your Alder to request a meeting between Resolution co-sponsors and City Staff to develop a workable divestment/contract plan. Think globally - act locally!

3 easy steps to contact your Alder!

- 3. Let PSR WI (info@psrwisconsin.org) know which Alder you reached and what their response was. This helps us track which Alders have been contacted and what their stance is.**

The 5 steps of Back from the Brink are: 1) actively pursuing a verifiable agreement among nuclear-armed states to eliminate their nuclear arsenals, 2) renouncing the option of using nuclear weapons first, 3) ending the president's sole, unchecked authority to launch a nuclear attack, 4) taking U.S. nuclear weapons off hair-trigger (high) alert and 5) cancelling the plan to replace the entire U.S. arsenal with enhanced weapons.
