Dr. James Allen Memorial \$1,000 Scholarship

Description

A \$1,000 scholarship is offered for the 2023-2024-academic year to a Madison East High School senior student who writes the best essay or makes the most thoughtful video discussing one of the topics below.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to any senior student at East HS who will graduate in 2024. Applicants must enroll at any post-secondary public technical school, technical training program or public college/university by the fall of 2024.

Deadline

The application deadline is June 1, 2024.

Application Requirements

A completed application package includes (1) the application <u>cover sheet</u>, (2) a *typed*, *double-spaced 500 word essay* **OR** a 2-3 minute video, and (3) a recent grade transcript. In addition, two letters of reference should be <u>independently</u> sent to the scholarship committee. Applications without supporting letters of reference will not be considered. See the *note at end of these requirements.

• Complete the *application cover sheet*. Photocopied forms are acceptable. Application materials are available in your school counseling office. Application information may also be down-loaded through the web site at http://madisonvfp.org. If you prefer to have an application mailed to you, contact Paul McMahon (call 608-215-5031 or text your name and address.)

Submit a 500 word typed (double-spaced) essay or make a 2-3 minute video expressing your thoughts on any one of the following topics:

- What I hope to accomplish with further work and skill training
- Why I believe violence is not an answer to community problems
- What I would do for others if given both authority and resources
- What I would do if I won the lottery

Applicants should provide the Committee's mailing address (or email address) to whomever will be submitting the letter of reference as well as the school office issuing grade transcripts.

Award Notification

The Committee will notify the winning applicant on or about June 10. The award check will be paid to the winning student upon enrollment confirmation in a post-secondary education/training program.

Include your **typed** essay or video with this application form. To be eligible, students must meet all requirements for this scholarship and submit all required materials by the deadline, whether postmarked or attached to an email. Late applications are not considered.

Grade transcripts and Letters of reference must be independently submitted by the school office or author to the post box address or email address. Provide the scholarship committee address (or email address) to letter writers and the school office. Lack of reference letters is disqualifying. VFP will notify the winner no later than June 10, 2024.
